

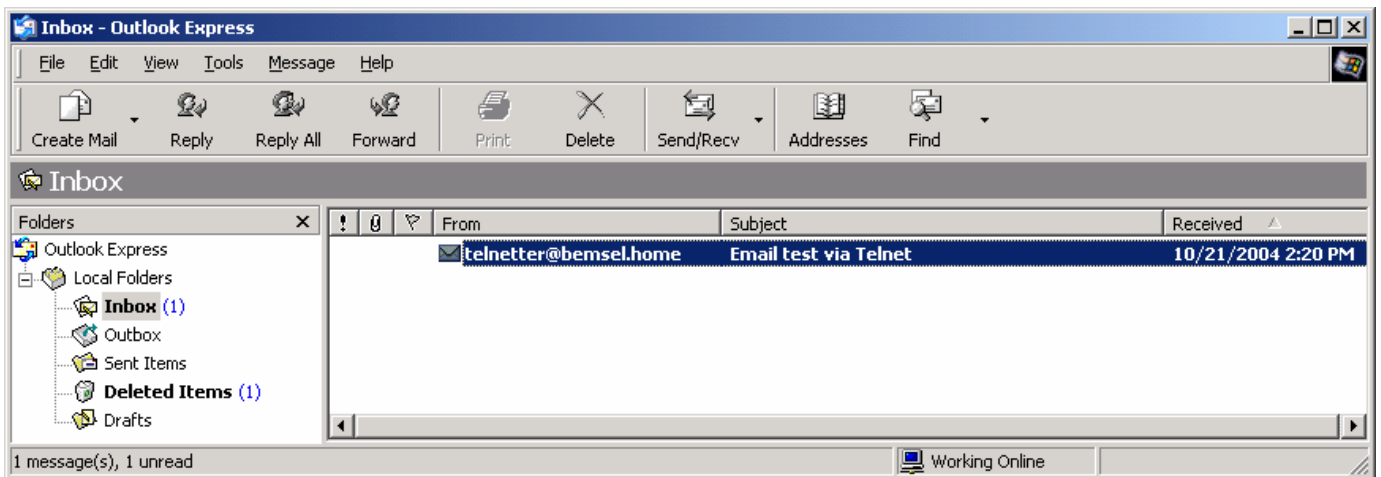


How to send Test Mail from Report Center

The purpose of this document is to provide you with some basic commands to send an email via Telnet from any Report Center to test Email Notification. I've used ESMTP Mail Enable Mail Server in my Home Lab. Some commands or replies may differ from your environment.

c:\> telnet mail-server 25 (or IP Address 25)
