Installing Solarwinds TFTP Server 5.0 (2002 Standard Edition)

I was looking for an up-to-date TFTP Server and found a free to use TFTP Server from Solarwinds.net.

This is what Solarwinds says about it:

"While there are many TFTP Servers already available, we were working on a large network audit project and need a **Multi-Threaded** TFTP Server that could handle many file transfers simultaneously. We could not find one that was reliable. So . . . we created one and we offer it to you as freeware not shareware. The SolarWinds TFTP Server has the ability to send and receive multiple files concurrently. This TFTP Server is commonly used to upload/download executable images and configurations to routers, switches, hubs, XTerminals, etc. The TFTP Server form SolarWinds will run on any Microsoft Operating System including Windows 95, 98, NT, ME and even Windows XP. "

- 1. Doubleclick on Solarwinds-TFTP-Server.exe and Installation Wizard will occur.
- 2. Welcome Window comes up = Click on **NEXT**



3. Next Window will show the license Agreement. In order to continue the installation you will have to accept all the terms. If you agree, click on **YES**

5. The installation is in progress. When all files are finished a final window occurs telling you that SolarWinds TFTP Server has been successfully installed / Click on **FINISH** and you are done with the installation





6. To start TFTP Server, go to Programs / SolarWinds 2002 Standard Edition / TFTP Server
