



## Installing & Configuring Virex 7.21 on MAC OS X 10.2.7

The purpose of this document is to provide a cheat sheet on how to install & configure Anti-Virus protection on MAC OS X with McAfee Security's VIREX 7.21. It's not my intension to replace any official documentation or release notes.

### System Requirements

- Apple MacIntosh OS X 10.0.3 or newer operating system
- Power PC G3 or above
- At least 12 Megabytes of free disk space

### Used Equipment

- Apple Macintosh OS X 10.2.7
- Powerbook G4 1,25 Ghz , 1GB Memory

### Installation

Locate the File Virex72.gz and copy it to your Harddisk. Installing from CD ROM will result to crash Stuffit Expander. Locate the copied file on your harddisk



Double click on Virex72.gz and file will be extracted.



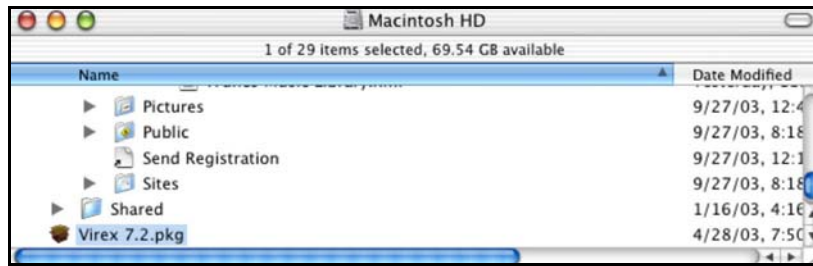
Locate the new package file, called Virex 7.2.pkg



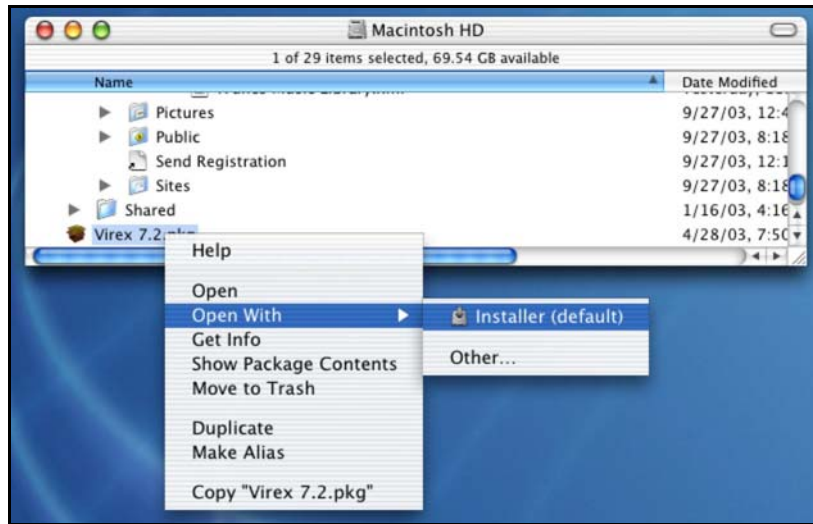

Right click on the file and open with Installer



Before installing is allowed, you will be prompted to authenticate with your password. Make sure you have administrative rights.



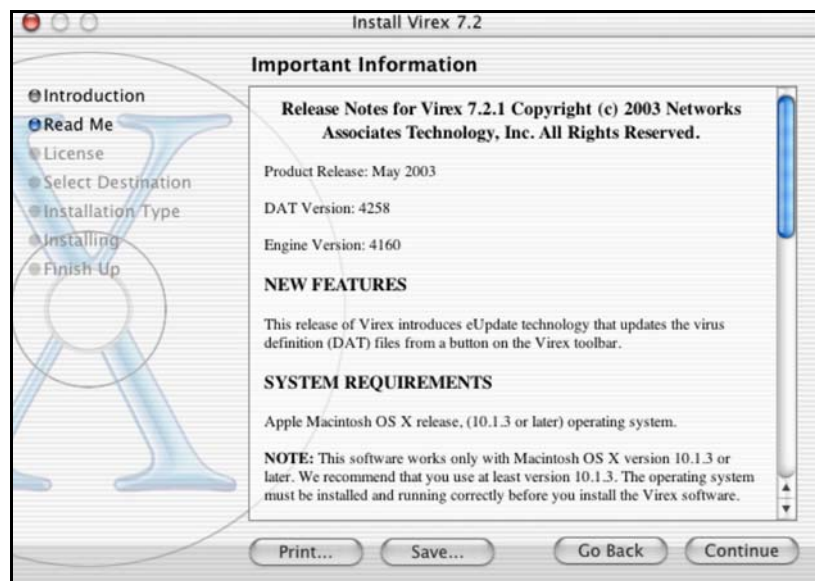
The welcome window appears.

Next, you should see the Release Notes of Virex 7.2.1.



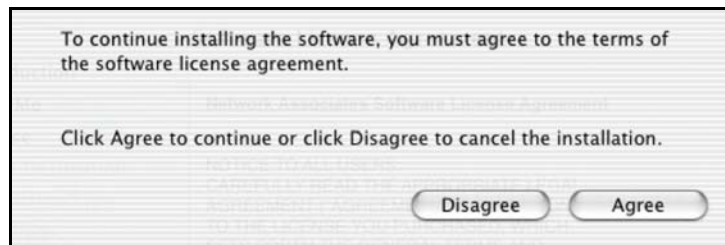
Click on **CONTINUE**

Next, you will get Software License Agreement.

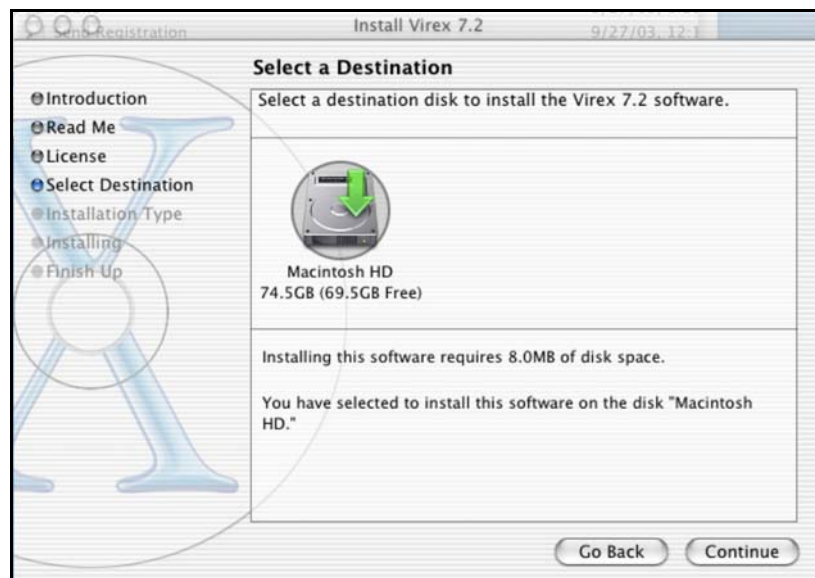




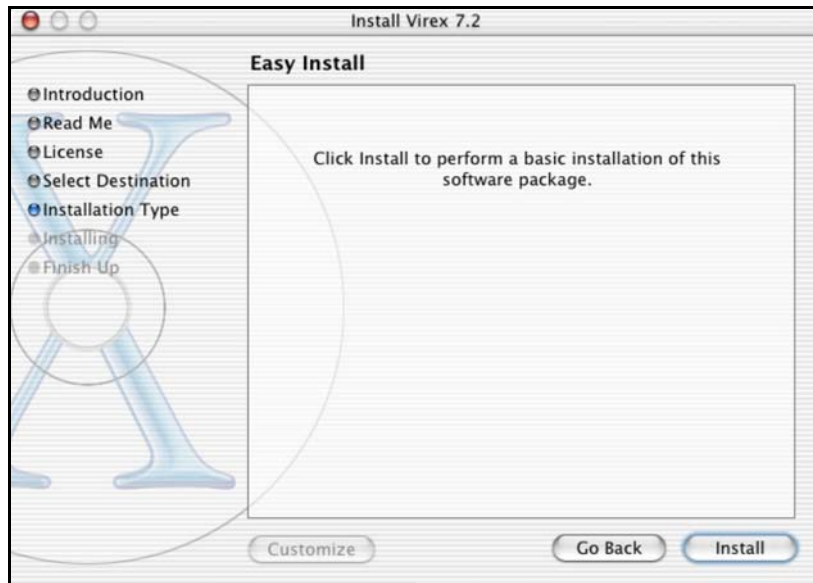
Click on **CONTINUE** Next you will have to Agree on the terms in order to continue the installation



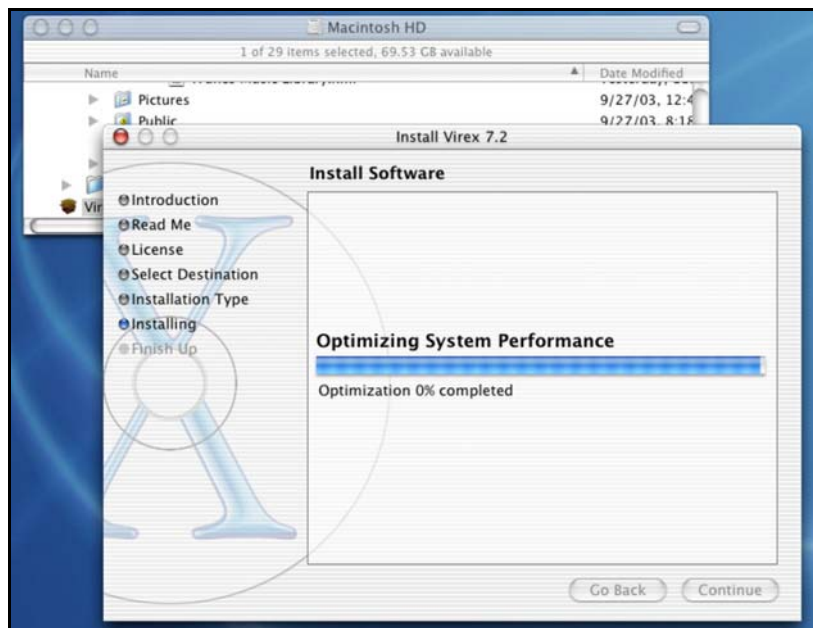
Click on **AGREE** to continue the installation. Next, select a Destination disk to install the Virex 7.21 software.



Click on **CONTINUE**



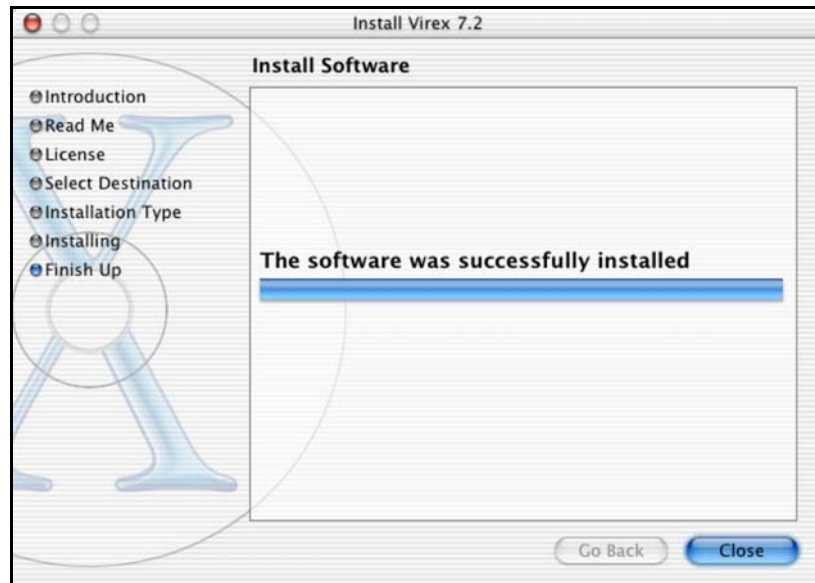
Click **Install** to perform a basic installation of this software package.
